## Planning Board Gives Approval To 4 Applications

### General Electric To Manufacture Small Parts Here

Four applications to operate business establishments were approved at a November 21 meeting of the Planning Board of Mountainside.

An application for a General Electric plant to manufacture small parts in a portion of a building at 1124 G. Ave. was approved. The company plans to manufacture spare parts for engines and to maintain offices and a training center in the site. Carbor-Hoechst, which occupies approximately 10,000 square feet of the 2,000 square foot building, will continue its business there. General Electric will take over the balance of the building.

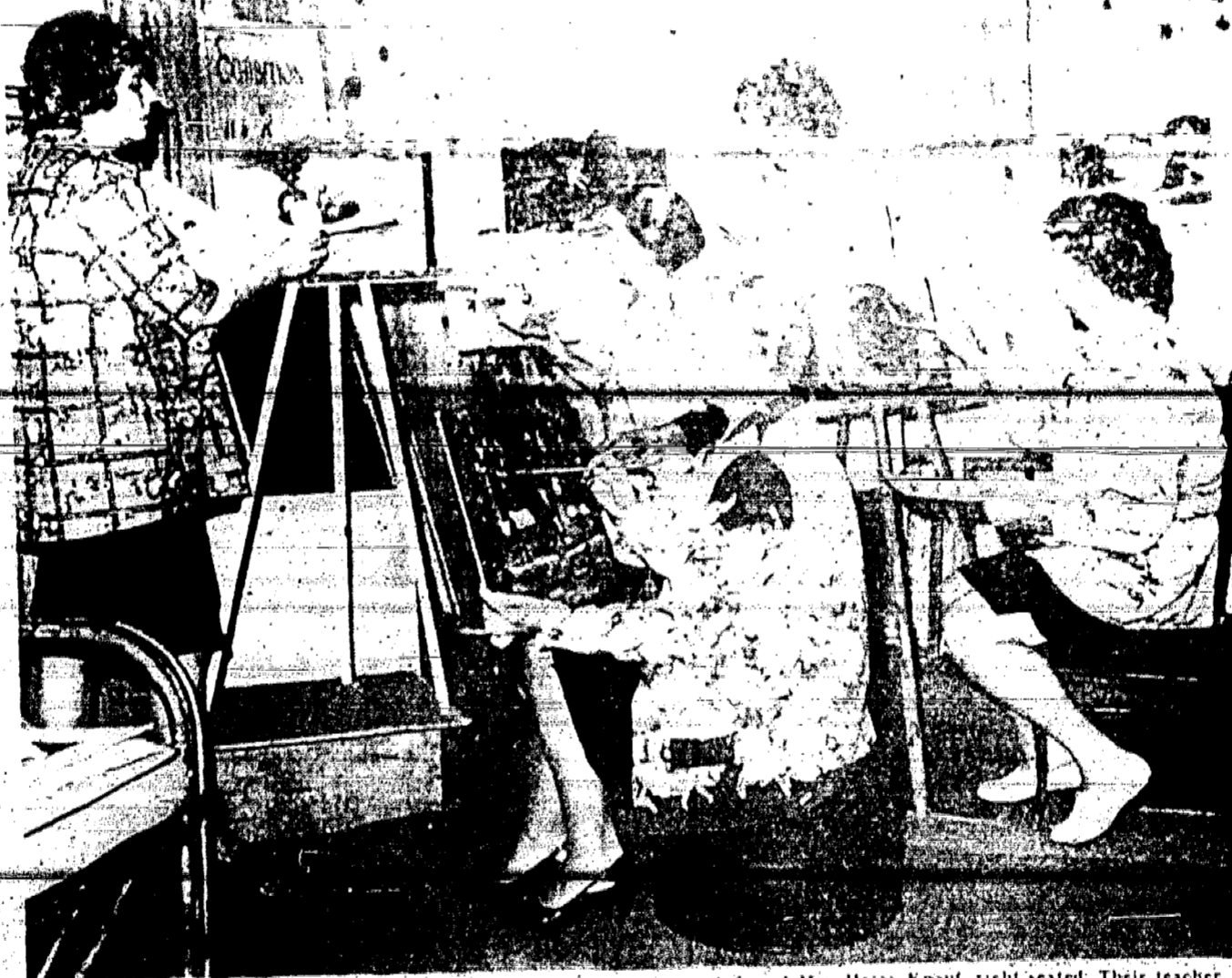

A related application submitted by Gishemill Co., owner of the building, for approval of plans for interior work on the building in preparation for General Electric's occupancy was referred to Jack Dyer, chairman of the Board's committee on matters.

An application from the California Chemical Co., now operating at 1119 Springfield St., Union, asking permission to increase its 1021 Bristol St. Mountain side, received unanimous approval from the five board members present.

A representative of the firm stated that the operation is strictly a research project, with no mass production involved.

**Freight Lines Get OK**

The Quinn Freight Lines, which has its home office in Brocton, Mass., was granted permission to operate at 1133 Rt. 22. The company will maintain offices at that site and use it as a stop-off for its tractor-trailers.

Approval was also given to Victoria Stein to take over the operation of an existing restaurant in the Echo Lanes Bowling building.

The Somerset Bus Co. applied for permission to construct a concrete and steel radio mast on the roof of the rear of its building on Rt. 22. The board granted approval provided the mast, which will be 147.5 feet high, will be no higher than the distance between its location and any public right of way. The mast will replace the present one which is used to send messages to buses on the routes.

Two members of the board, the chairman, Albert Hartung, and Thomas Hyde, expressed satisfaction that the present mast will be replaced with one of stronger construction, saying they have often worried about the possibility of the present one toppling over and injuring someone.

**Four One-Family Homes**

Conditional approval was given to Sylvan Green Development Corp. to erect four one-family homes on four lots on Summit rd. The board stipulated that before final approval is given, sufficient bond must be posted to cover the construction of concrete curbing on the line facing Summit rd.

The bond will be set by Borough Engineer Robert Koser. The board also stipulated that plans for the homes, which will be priced around \$35,000, must be approved by the Borough Council.

A representative of Sylvan Green Development asked the board to approve the plan.

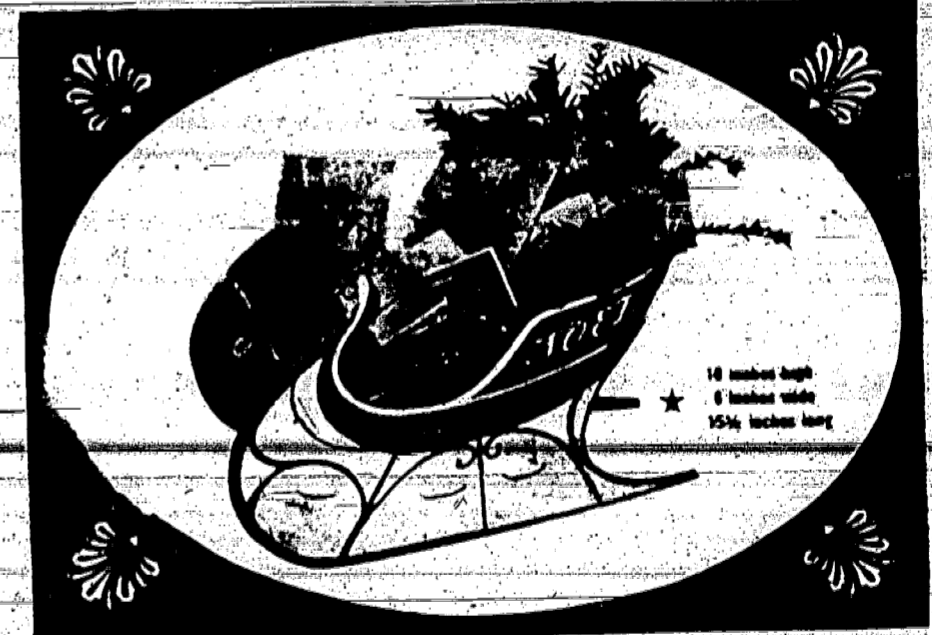



# A Little Radiation May Be Good For You -- So Says Rutgers Prof

A little radiation may be good for you, according to a paper presented before the American Nuclear Society in San Francisco yesterday. Dr. Francis J. Jankowski, a Rutgers University professor, pointed to a study of the effects of small doses of radiation on the human body.

Dr. Jankowski's study was based on a series of experiments in which small doses of radiation were administered to a group of subjects. The results showed that small doses of radiation had a beneficial effect on the human body, particularly in the area of the immune system.

Dr. Jankowski's findings are significant because they suggest that small doses of radiation may be used to treat certain types of cancer and other diseases. Essex And Union County Concerns Awarded \$6 Million In Contracts

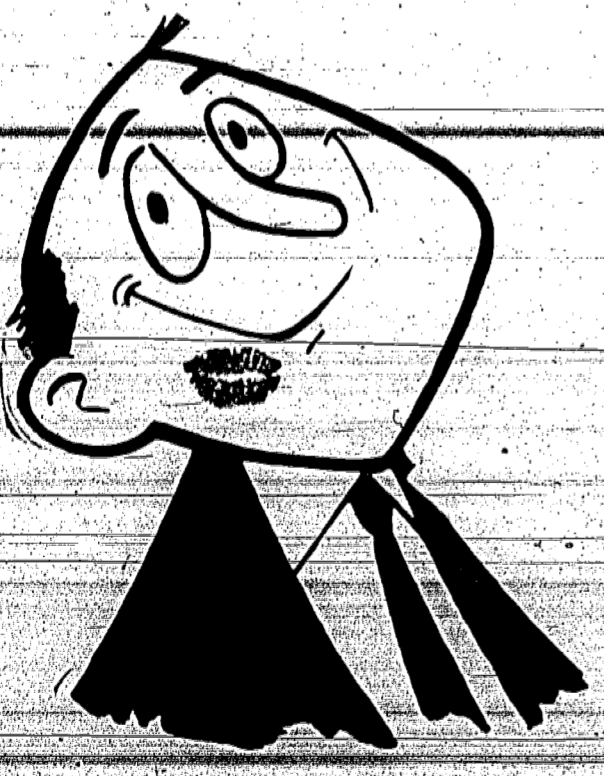
