Friends Tell 'How To' Of Family Yule

DETERGENT DOLLS

To make the gay Christmas carolers you need empty detergent bottles, stones or sand to weight bottles, white glue, and white styrofoam balls (2" in diameter), bright pieces of felt or wool, scissors and staples.

Remove label, wash and dry bottle. Add stones or sand. Spread glue on top of opening and impale ball on it for head. Cut out felt hats, skirts and long coats to avoid cutting and fitting trousers; use wool for scarves and kerchiefs. A stapler or needle and thread is used to close the materials as you dress the figures.

So simple to make, they can be used over and over again.

For each figure you will need two white pipe cleaners, a wooden bead and a circle of white tulle, 3" in diameter.

You will also need glue, flippers, paints, pieces of gold color scouring sponge, needle and thread, green and red sequins and wire for hairing.

Clip a piece of pipe cleaner 2" long. Glue one end into the bead. Bend the other end up close to form body. Clip a piece 3" long for arms, twist to hold directly under the head and bend up hands. Clip a 3" piece for legs. Twist around body and pull down, bending up the feet. Sew red ribbon around upper arms and

body for the sleeveless dress. Glue sequins on tulle, cut hole in center and sew to body for circular skirt. Tie green ribbon around body with a bow in back for sash. Glue piece of scouring sponge to head for curly hair. Fasten a sequin or two in the curly hair. Paint heart shaped mouth, eyes with long lashes and eyebrows on each pink little dancer. And wire loop for hanging on tree.

CHRISTMAS DANCERS

\$63,008 Increase In School Budget Livingston Vocalists Plan Yule Program

The Mountainside Board of Education Tuesday night adopted a tentative budget of \$1,007,170.50 for 1965-66. This figure represents an increase of \$63,008 or 6.7 percent over the current budget of \$944,111.

It was explained that the major items contributing to the increase are provisions for salary increases for all personnel, an additional teaching position, an increased subsidy of the summer school program which will eliminate summer school tuition on all basic courses and a modern bookkeeping machine for the business manager's office.

Other items are the addition of a psychiatric consultant, a part-time social worker and hiring of a clerk for the special services team and the purchase of a typewriter. It was explained that 50 percent of the team members salaries and operating costs of the program will be reimbursed by the state.

The amount to be raised by taxation will increase above \$65,932 due to an anticipated reduction in state aid and a limited surplus available for capitalization to go toward the budget.






After graduation, he went to work for the John Curran Laboratories in Teaneck.


He worked there for two years and then moved to New York City where he became a sales representative for the company.





WEEDER'S DIGEST

SOAK TO BE SURE**
Soak everything down. This may be about the last you'll hear from this corner this season about late fall insurance for your shrubs and perennials.

The advance comes from Lacey, home horticulture specialist at Rutgers.

He offers it because he thinks many growers may be fooled by the appearance of dry soil.

Damp, maybe, but dry soil is wet down where it counts around the roots.

Mr. Lacey says again that if you can't use the water from your lawn, you can save rinsed Christmas tree water for a laundry. If you bucket by sea, add fertilizer to support them. It's best to soak the soil around the plants, making sure all the water goes down.



Put off your soaking too late and you may find that your water will run off the frozen soil. Soak everything down.


This may be about the last you can begin to mulch with salt hay or other loose stuff now. That will help hold moisture and also keep the soil from warming up during the winter.

As you get caught up in the Christmas rush you can drive stakes to support your bushes.

Or you can use the rocks of evergreen boughs as a hedge break. String wires between stakes to support them. It's best to bury them.



New Minimum Standard Deduction Will Cut Taxes

(This is one of a continuing series of releases from the Newark District Office of the Internal Revenue Service.)

The new minimum standard deduction provision, which went into the 1964 tax law will cut

tax bills for an estimated 13 million people who earn less than \$10,000 a year. This provision will free six million taxpayers of any tax liability if their total income is less than the amount of the tax law after it goes into effect. See also SHARON.

For a justified couple with

two children, exemptions for the two children would be no tax for pay under their income brackets. At \$10,000, this would leave three exemptions, or \$12,000 tax-free income, or \$18,000 tax bill instead of \$24,000 without the deduction. Returns of average income would be \$10,000 if no tax deduction were taken. At \$12,000, the tax bill would be \$18,000. The new minimum standard deduction would save approximately \$1,200.

The new minimum standard deduction applies to tax filers whose adjusted gross income is a \$10,000 part of a tax-free exemption. It is available to those with incomes up to \$12,000. A tax-free deduction would be available for the tax filer or tax filers whose adjusted gross income is less than

the minimum standard deduction. Returns of average income would be \$10,000 if no tax deduction were taken. At \$12,000, the tax bill would be \$18,000.






