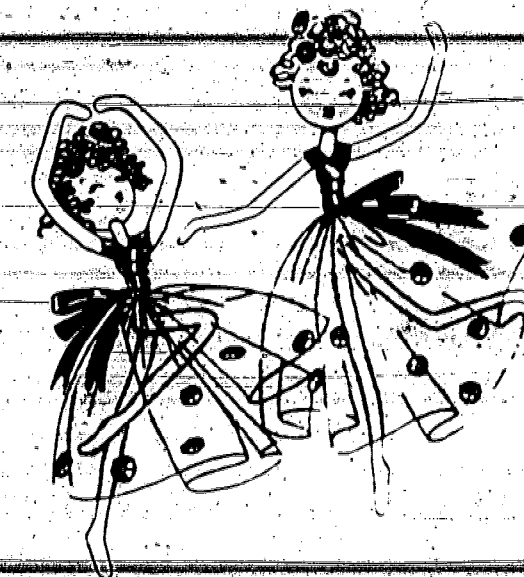

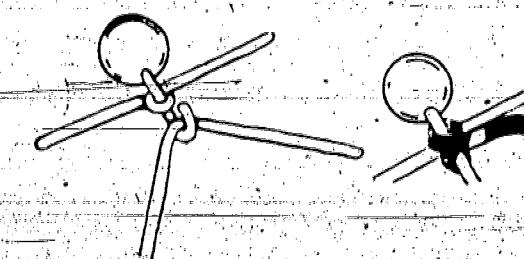
## Group Teaching Progress Report Given At Meeting

## \$63,008 Increase In School Budget

The Mountainside Board of Education Tuesday night adopted a tentative budget of \$1,007,170.50 for 1965-66. This figure represents an increase of \$63,008, or 6.7 percent, over the 1964-65 budget of \$944,162.50. It was explained that the major items contributing to the increase are provisions for salary increases for all personnel, an additional teaching position, an increased subsidy of the summer school program, which will eliminate summer school tuition on all basic courses and a modern bookkeeping machine for the business manager's office.

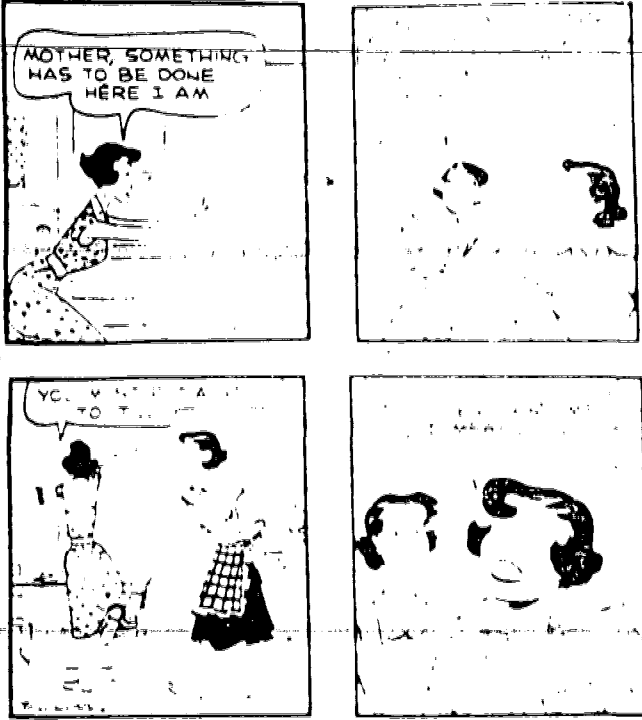

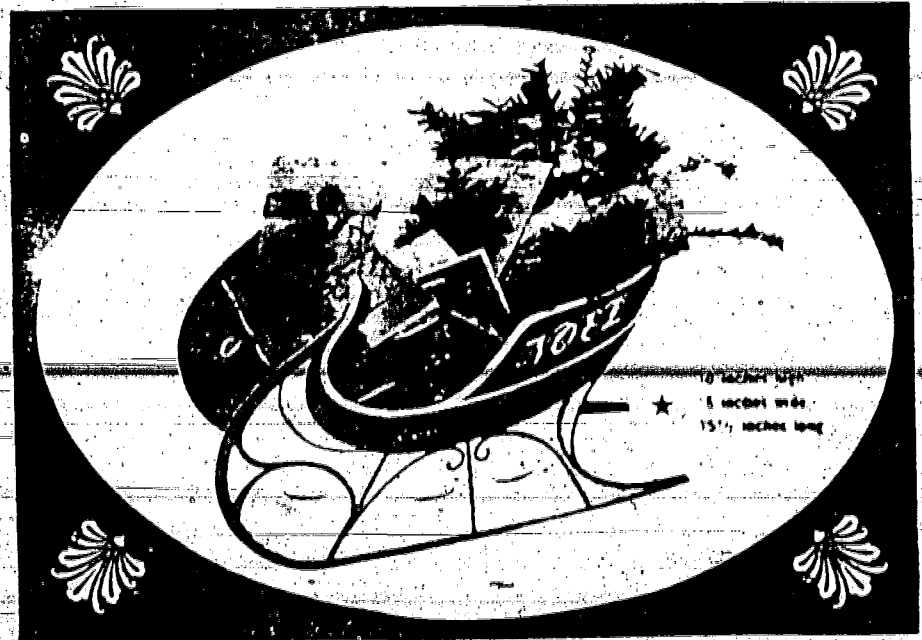

 Don't try to analyze what your husband says and what he means. Because if you keep riding him you will have a more annoying problem. How to shut him up.

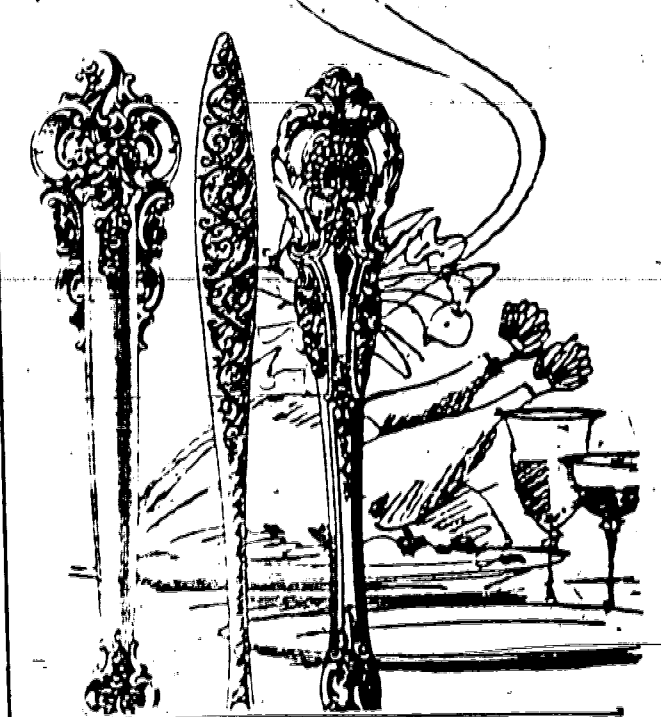
