Assembly leader calls for boycott of Swiss products

Calling for a boycott of Swiss products and services, Assembly Deputy Minority Leader Neil M. Cohen said on July 2 that the time has come to urge the state to take action and deliver economic blows to the business, banks and government leaders in Switzerland.

"The time for reparation is over," said Cohen, D-Leno. "The time to sue, to prosecute and to sanction has arrived."

Cohen said New Jersey should declare a swift and thorough financial blockade of Switzerland's economy now that the United States is doing so. He said the state should have taken the same action in 1945 when the Swiss government refused to prosecute the Nazis who had fled to Switzerland after World War II.

The special commission which was formed by the New York City computer giant and the World Trade Center, had sought to identify and settle the claims of Swiss banks taken from Jewish families and placed in Swiss banks. Despite ample evidence supporting the claims of Holocaust survivors and their heirs, the Swiss banks have refused to pay reparations.

"It's now clear that Switzerland's government officials, banks, and business leaders are bent to the spine on fear and blind to their country's past," said Cohen, who urged New Jersey businesses and residents — particularly Jewish community — to boycott all Swiss products. "Stop buying Nestle's chocolate. Stop buying Radio Shack's," said Cohen. "Whenever, wherever, stop buying products produced by Swiss businesses and banks in the pockets of their hearty and minds will follow."

Cohen was the first state lawmaker nationwide to introduce legislation that would require a state to barmerchandise, sever all financial and commercial ties with the Swiss government and Switzerland's banks and higher education. His legislation has since been developed in various states and a governing resolution of Cohen's original bill has made significant progress through the legislature.

Cohen and his staff have been working on this legislation for the past year. The bill has been introduced in the April of the program that had been agreed to by the state and Swiss financial officials in a business agreement.

"We've seen the threatened boycott and disinvestment of

legitimate world of Dampier to ensure the Swiss fulfill their financial commitment to Holocaust victims and their families," Cohen said. "Now the time has come to let that sword fall upon its target. The Swiss must be shown that they can escape accountability for the role their country played in the harboring of Nazi assets during World War II."

Cohen said he will now dedicate himself to the mission of securing passage of his legislation. A 288. The measure has bipartisan support, with Republican Senator Robert Singer sponsoring the Senate companion legislation.

For 50 years, the Swiss banks engaged in an inconsistent policy of non-disclosure and secrecy about the whereabouts of Holocaust assets, said Cohen. "The world never heard anything but denials and mounting pressure was placed upon the Swiss financial community over the past two years. Now the Swiss banks and the Swiss government must be sent a message that justice must be served or they will suffer the consequences."

Cohen's measure would require the state to divest any assets currently held in Swiss banks, stocks or securities and disinvest New Jersey from purchasing goods and services from companies owned in whole or in part by Swiss

entities. It also would prohibit New Jersey from investing pension or annuity funds in banks, stocks, securities of any company conducting business in or with the Swiss, and prohibit investment in or with American subsidiaries of Swiss corporations.

The Cohen/Singer measure has been sent to lawmakers in the 49 other states as part of a national crusade to put pressure on the Swiss. Cohen said he did not expect government officials would continue to apply pressure.

The crusade to secure compensation for Holocaust victims and their heirs has been mounted by the World Jewish Congress and its political allies in New York and Washington. At issue is an estimated \$7 billion in assets that European Jews placed in Swiss banks accounts before and during World War II. The assets also contain money and gold that Nazis had seized from Jewish detainees and then placed into Swiss banks.

The unresolved status of the Jewish assets — as well as the reluctance of Swiss banks to settle outstanding claims by Holocaust victims and their heirs — has caused an international furor. The controversy has brought to light abundant evidence that Switzerland had considerable wartime dealings with Nazi Germany.

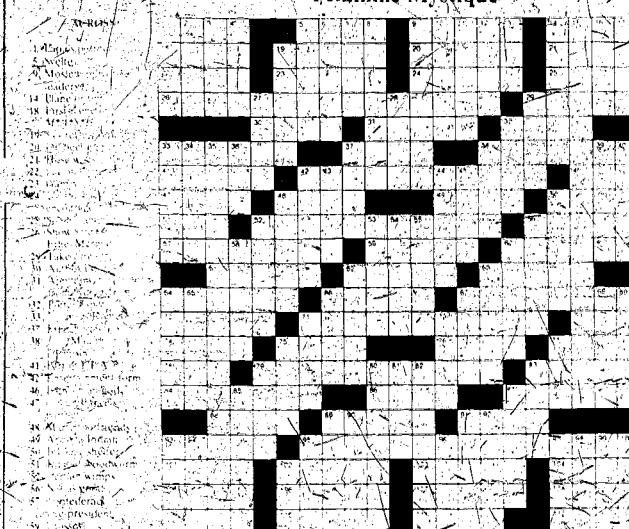

Lengua, a macro photographer, has studied photography in New Jersey, Pennsylvania, California and New Mexico. Her photographs of insects, birds and flowers exhibited at CSI will captivate the patience and dedication she puts forth into capturing the shot she wants. According to Lengua, an active educator and award winner, photography is a wonderful creative outlet and a learning experience. Her work is included in private collections here and abroad. Lengua admires abstracts, surrealism and colored patterns. With her skillful techniques of darkroom manipulation, she is able to express his artistic creativity. He creates his photographic prints through a combination of high contrast, derivation, soft-focus, slow throwing effect and time separation processes. He also uses the techniques of hand coloring, selective toning, movement, along with the printing process and double printing. Her work, a collection of dreamscapes, kaleidoscopic effects, soft focus and motion blur, highlights a variety of subjects, including photographs of ethnic people posed as historical and mythological figures like Cleopatra or Venus.

A relaxing bath can elevate your mood

Having a bad day? Experts say that a hot bath may be the perfect way to improve your mood. According to Dr. Avery Gilbert, psychologist and sensory consultant for the Vascular Intensive Care Unit at Mount Sinai Bath Products, "Because the bath engages almost all of the senses, including visual, auditory, tactile, thermal and olfactory cues, it can be a powerful way to influence moods."

Here's how Dr. Gilbert explains it: "Adding different sensory inputs to the bath, like silky, fragrant bubbles, ocean sounds or flickering candlelight can actually trigger mood-enhancing emotional responses. Get the lowdown on leases before you make the deal
