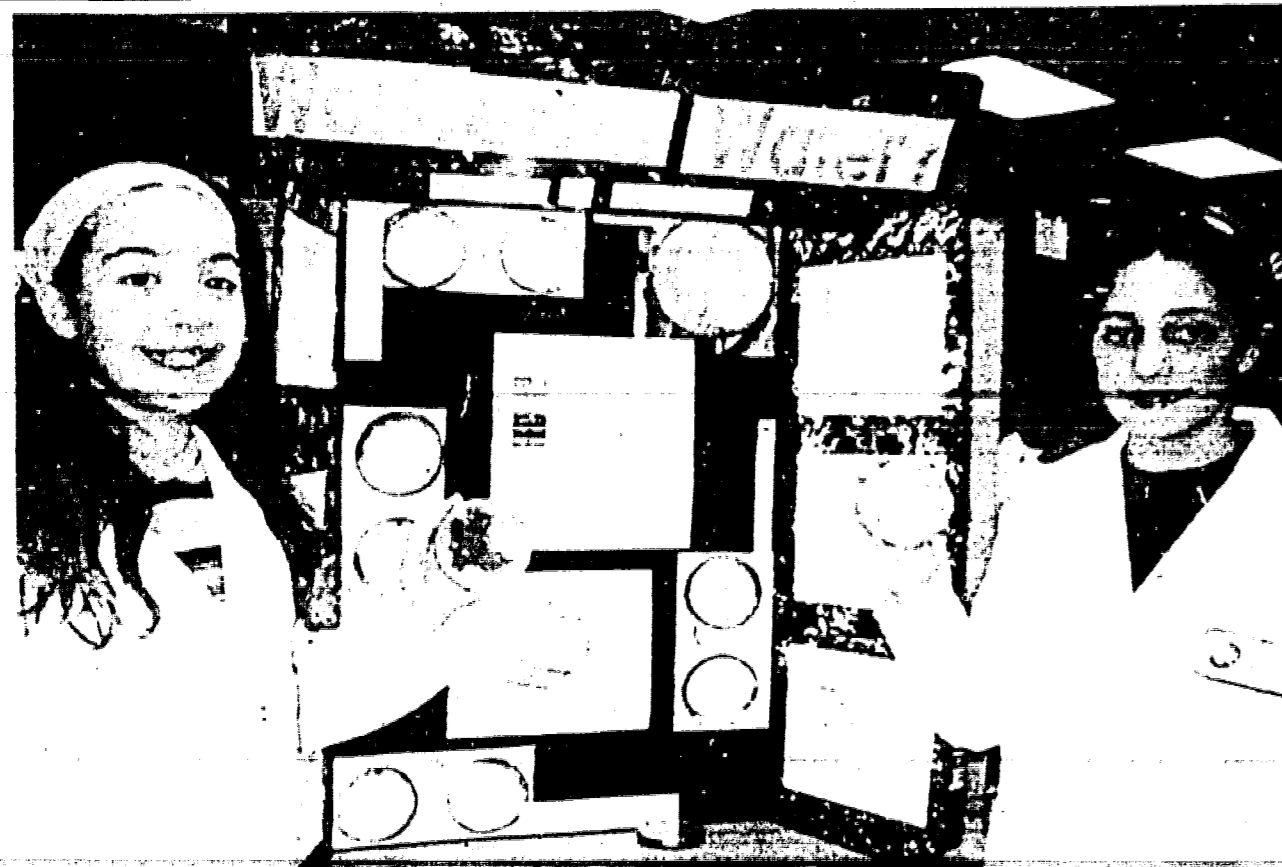


Wonders of science explored

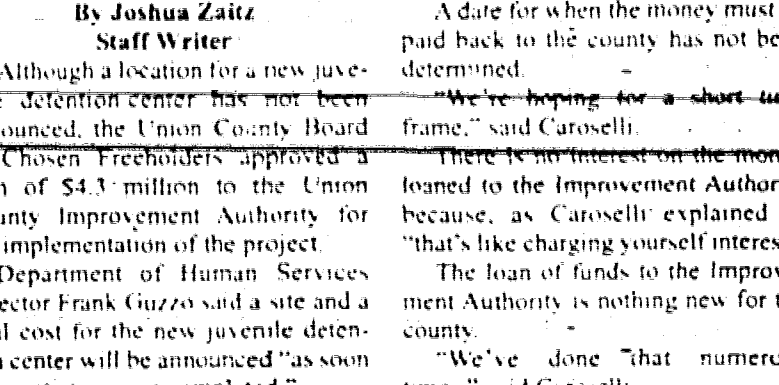

My Rollatini consisted of eggplant with ham, ricotta, mozzarella and romano - a wonderful blend of flavors and very good. The portions were large - what we didn't finish we had wrapped.

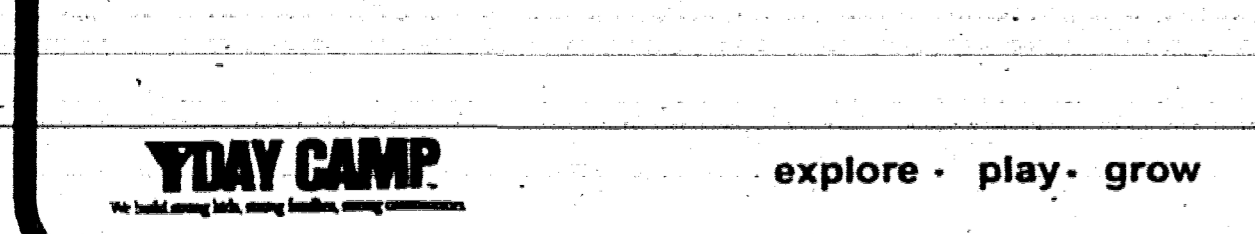
