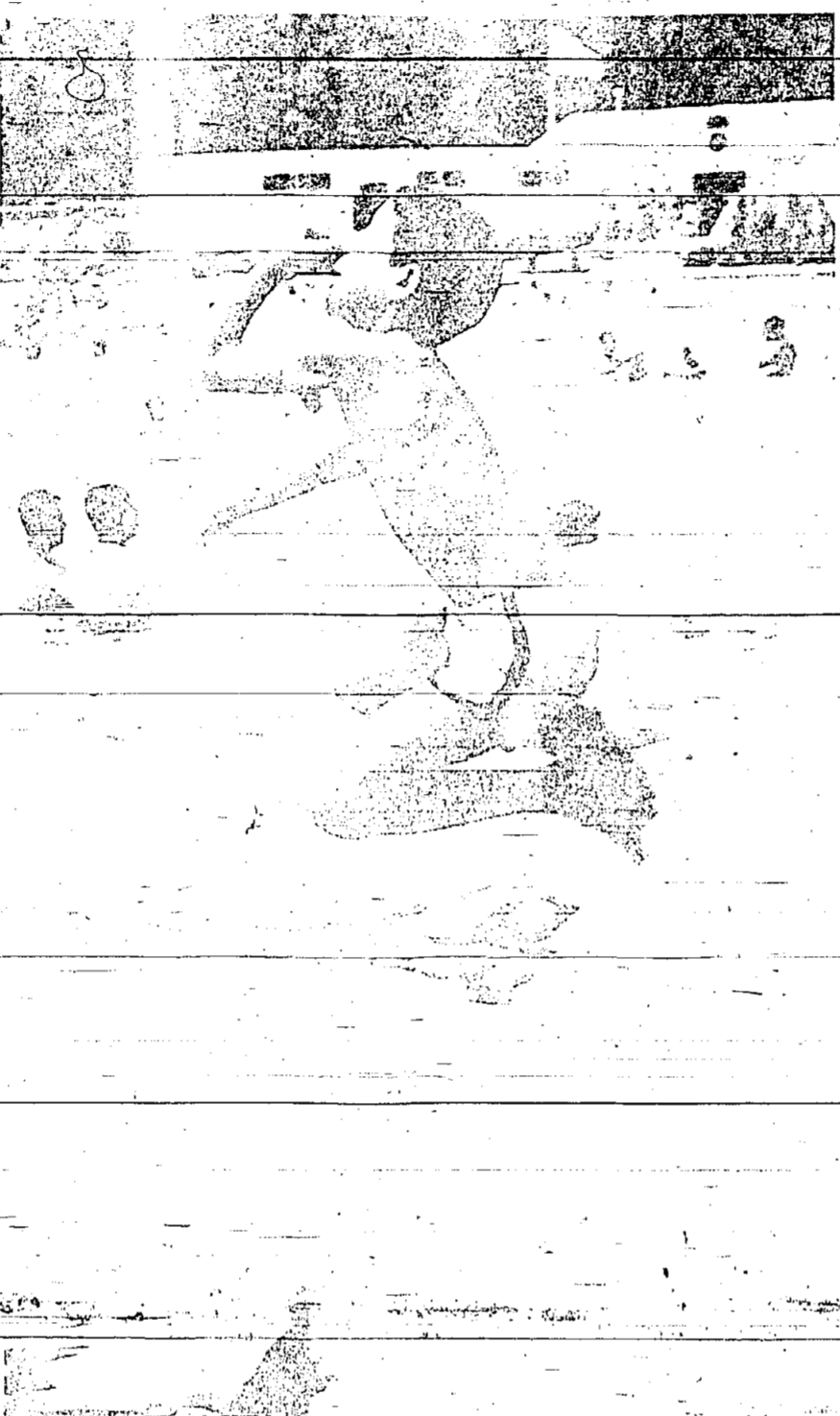

No date has yet been set for a grand jury investigation into the April 6 murder of Elizabeth Malgeri, 39, of 32 Pitt rd., Springfield, who allegedly killed Angelo R. "Pickles" Piccolotta, a 42-year-old Elizabeth gambling figure.

The Springfield father of five children is free in \$15,000 bail awaiting grand jury action. The Union County Prosecutor's Office earlier this week said no date had been set.

Malgeri, owner of the Club Lu-Mai on Rt. 1 in Elizabeth, is suspected of killing Piccolotta outside the tavern. The victim died of a brain hemorrhage, according to the Union County Medical examiner's office.

At that time Grifo had also said that relocation might have to wait the completion of the new highways. The old meeting place on Morris ave. was lost to the group when the land and building were taken by the state for the highway projects.
