Determination is key Paraplegics gain independence

Encouragement and independence on the part of paraplegics is the key to their success, according to a study by the University of Illinois at Chicago. The study, conducted by Dr. Robert G. Barr, found that paraplegics who were determined to overcome their physical limitations were more successful in achieving independence than those who were not. The study involved 100 paraplegics who were interviewed about their lives and their attitudes towards their disabilities. The results showed that those who were determined to overcome their disabilities were more likely to be employed, to have a home, and to be socially active than those who were not determined to do so.

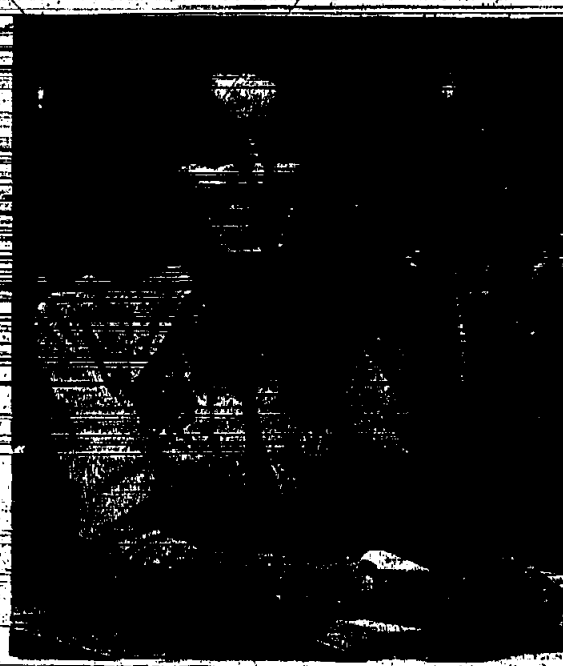

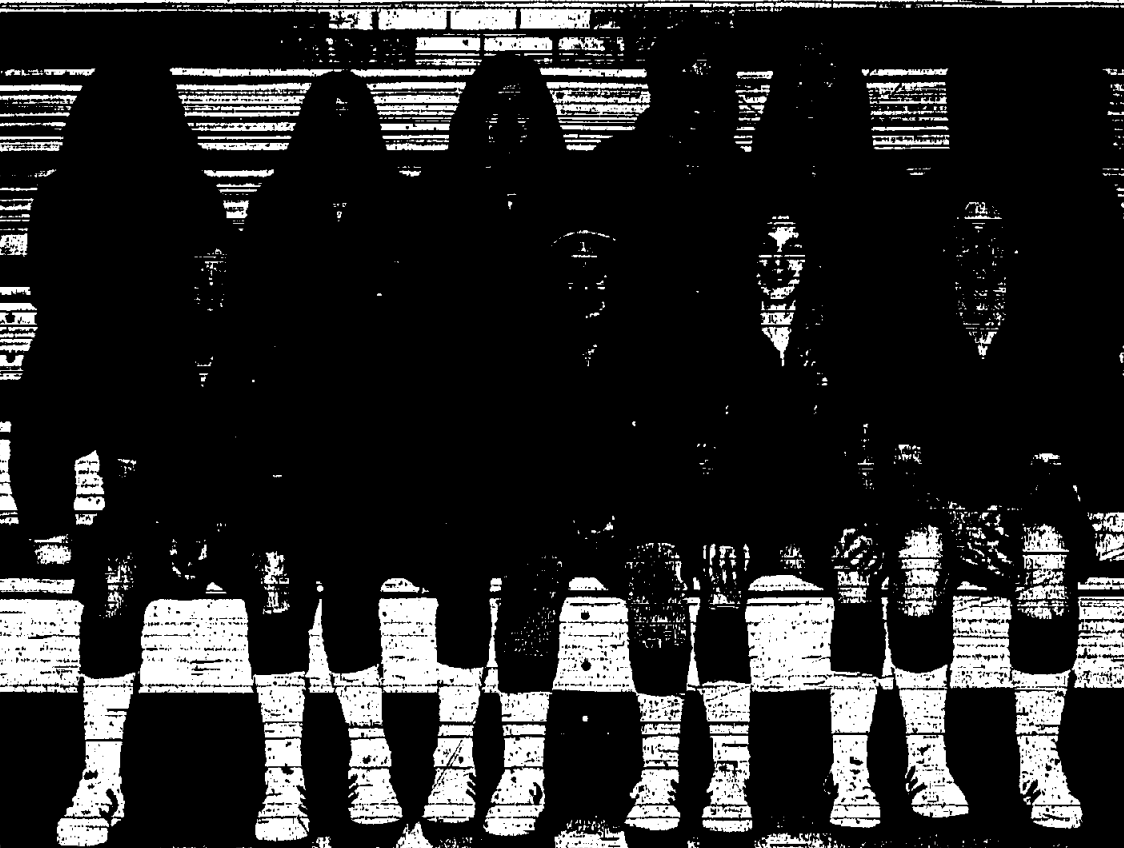
