

All board candidates back education budget for 1975

All five candidates for three seats on the Springfield Board of Education Monday night expressed strong support for the local school budget, calling for \$23 million to be paid by local taxes, which will be presented in the voters on Tuesday's election.

The candidates—Arthur Alexander, Richard LaVigne, Doris Gites, Charles Colm and August Cipriani—took part in the annual candidates' night debate at the Lawrence Guideline School sponsored by the League of Women Voters of the Springfield PTAC.

The candidates also voiced agreement on other matters under recent consideration by the board. They all supported elimination of any administrative positions at the time of a continuing search for a superintendent, and all opposed the "restructuring" of the board. They also agreed to support the recommendations of the Board of Education's study on the school's financial situation.

The candidates also agreed to support the superintendent's resignation, which was announced last month. Margaret Walker, a former LWW national official from Westfield, was endorsed.

No criticism of the budget was available from the candidates. They all agreed to support the budget, which is being presented to the voters on Tuesday.
