Factory workers hourly earnings exceed \$5 mark

Average hourly earnings of New York nonfarm workers in the Jersey area factory production sector passed the \$5 mark in January, rising five cents to \$5.01 between December and January. It was reported by Herbert Bernstein, regional commissioner of the U.S. Department of Labor's Bureau of Labor Statistics.

Bluestock noted that the gains have accelerated rapidly in recent years. It was less than three years ago that area factory workers earned the \$4 mark and in the next eight years ago that they reached the \$3 mark. It was over a 12-year period, 1956 to 1968, that earnings went from \$2 to \$3.

Bluestock pointed out, however, that the pace of consumer price increases has also accelerated rapidly in recent years. He said that real earnings fell since 1968, when average hourly earnings passed the \$3 point.

Expressed in terms of constant 1967 dollars, real hourly earnings, adjusted for changes in consumer prices, were down slightly by 1.7 percent between March 1975 and January 1976, a 2.8 percent drop in non-consumer prices.

In contrast, during the preceding 12-year period, average hourly earnings went from \$2.60 to \$3.60, a 38 percent rise. Average hourly earnings rose 15.9 percent in the entire 20-year period.

The average of \$5.01 was directly in line with the national average, but below average hourly earnings in over half of 175 areas across the country for which comparable data are available. Average hourly earnings levels at the end of 1975 ranged from a low of \$3.40 in Lewiston-Auburn, Maine area to a high of \$7.31 in Saginaw, Michigan.
