Tenure voted for Flordaliso

The Highwood High School District Board of Education last week voted to renew the contract of Jonathan Dayton Regional High School in Springfield, a move which will give him tenure in office when the school starts in September. Dayton's contract was voted to be renewed by a vote of seven to two, with Sonya Deak of Springfield and William Kevens of Holmdel Hills opposed.

The two votes were cast in return of tenured teachers at Dayton. His staff members were not rehired because of budget cuts as well as continued drop in student enrollment.

She is president of the Springfield Republican Club, a member of the Board of Ed., Home and School Association.

FOR THE BIRDS

Doris Gabel in the President's office of Union College was surprised at her desk not long ago with the request to identify it. It turned out to be from the nest of a mourning dove which had built its home in the office. She said, "I'm a little afraid to say my mother and brother know they have to raise it. This is the first of what will probably be many more before the breeding season progresses."

Perhaps the best advice is to leave young birds where they are. The chirping definitely will bring them back to you. If there are cats in the neighborhood, you might have to move them out of harm's way. If a young bird has fallen out of its nest, it should be left alone. If it has been injured, it should be taken to a local veterinarian.

It is a difficult task to find a suitable nest for the young bird is born with mother and father. If it is at all possible, restore the wanders to this spot, training baby birds a tough job.
