Each-day-from-8-to-9-a.m. and 2 to 4 p.m. one directs traffic at the Mountain avenue crossing of Morris avenue, From 4 to 6 p.m. she is at the Center street and Morris intersection, where Newark to Morristown traffic flows in a constant-procession.
