New Organ For Local Church Is Being Built

As the initial step in a projected program of renovation, expansion and improvement of its Main street facilities, the Springfield Methodist Church this week announced the purchase of a new, \$10,000 Moller pipe or-i gan, with delivery and installation set for a year hence. Construction will commence shortly in Hagerstown, Maryland, - plant of M. P. Moller, Inc.

The organ will be a two-manual instrument, consisting of the great, the swell and the pedal organs. There will be approximately_450_pipes, ranging_in_size from 16 feet to eight inches in length. Some of the pipes; such as the bass and flue notes, will be of wood, while others, such as the diapason,--strings-and-trumpets, will be made of metal. The wind blowing the pipes will be sup-plied by a-blower-unit-requiring a one and a half horsepower motor. The console, or control center will be all electric and several miles of wiring will connect it to the pipe unit:

Before installation date, the Church will have to prepare sufficient quarters for the instrument. Wilfred Barz, organist and choir director, Rev. Marvin Green, pastor, and representalives—of—the—organ—company—as well-as the church-and-architect ural firm retained by the Church." will meet to map plans for installation.


The organ will be custom-built designed specifically for the local Church after a meticulous study of the acoustics, seating capacity (Continued on page 2)


Record Crowd Sees July 4th **Program Here**

Springfield staged its greatest and most successful Fourth of July program on Monday, the elaborately planned and enjoyable celebration ending with a spectacular display of fireworks in the evening on the grounds of the Jonathan Dayton Regional High School.

Various-estimates of the-crowd-on hand for the big finale give figures up to 10,000. Vincent J. Bonadies, general chairman of the committee on arrangements. believes there were 10,000 people watching and participating Monday night's feature which in cluded-the-fireworks, community singing and square dancing in the school parking lot. Automobiles jammed all the streets in the vicinity of the high school grounds and every available space on the lawn or near the display was crowded with watchers. The fireworks display climaxed a full day's program, highlighted by the baby parade and the crowning-of Christine Callahan of Baltusrol as queen of the 1954 parade.
